
## How to Measure



### Chest:

Measure behind front legs and across broadest part of the test. Hold the tape firm and level. If the measurement falls between sizes, opt for the next size up.

#### Neck:

Measure at base of the neck. Note: Do not measure too high on the neck as it may result in a smaller than optimal measurement.

# Example of Breed

## Small:

Boston Terrier, Cairn Terrier, Dachshund, and Parson Russell Terrier

#### Medium:

Australian Cattle Dog, Beagle, Border Collie, Brittany Spaniel, Portuguese Water Dog, and Siberian Husky

#### Large:

Belgian Malinois, Boxer, Dalmation, English Setter, Pointer, Golden & Labrador retrievers, and Irish Setter

## X-Large:

Alaskan Malamute, Bloodhound, Doberman Pinscher, and German Shepherd
