- Vitamins and Minerals
- Chick Grit
- First Aid Kit (*optional*)
- Outdoor Coop



FEEDING CHART FOR POULTRY AND DUCKS



BIRD TYPE	AGE/STAGE	ROGUE FEED	GUIDELINES	NOTES
Chicks	(0-8 weeks)	Nature's Harmony Organic Chick Starter or Starter-Broiler	Free choice	Ensure constant access to feed and clean water.
Growers Turkeys	(8-20 weeks)	All In One Poultry Feed or Starter-Broiler	Free choice	Gradually transition from starter to grower feed.
Layers	(20+ weeks)	Egg Layer Pellets or Egg Layer Crumbles or Nature's Harmony Organic Layer Crumble or Nature's Harmony Organic Layer Pellets or Organic Soy-Free Layer Pellets	Free choice	Provide oyster shell for calcium, essential for egg production.
Broilers (Meat Birds)	All stages	Starter-Broiler	Free choice	Fast growth requires high-protein feed.
Ducklings	(0-6 weeks)	Nature's Harmony Organic Chick Starter	Free choice	High protein for starting growth.
Ducks	(6-20+ weeks)	All In One Poultry Feed	Free choice	High protein for continued growth.
Supplement Feeds	All stages	Cracked Corn, Steam Flaked Corn, Whole Wheat, Hen Scratch or Nature's Harmony Feed Certified Organic Hen Scratch	As a treat or supplement, not as a sole diet	Offer in moderation to avoid nutritional imbalances.
